Hospira Inc., a Pfizer company ("Hospira"), is recalling the above-referenced lot of **25% Dextrose Injection, USP** due to confirmed reports that the expiration date printed on the syringe (1AUG2021) is incorrect and does not match the expiration date on the carton (1AUG2019). The expiry on this product has been extended through FDA and the extended use date is 1DEC2019. The potential risk to patients arising from this issue is considered to be negligible. To date, Hospira has not received any reports of adverse events associated with this lot.

The recall of the above-referenced lot of **25% Dextrose Injection, USP** is being conducted to the **hospital/retail level**.

The Board of Pharmacy strongly encourages pharmacies to immediately review their quality assurance and recall policies and procedures to determine if any corrective action is required.
